Our final special offering of the year is always the Christmas Joy offering. With this we recognize the needs of church leaders – retired and in training at the beginning of their careers. Retired pastors and church workers sometimes have special needs for housing or medical care. Students in theological training sometimes need financial help to make it through school.

At Christmas we are joyful that Jesus was born to lead us in new faith. Last year our Christmas Joy offering was part of \$1.1 million of grants, to provide income, and housing supplements and emergency grants for current and retired Presbyterian church worker in their times of need. Income supplements from the Board of Pensions helped 278 individuals. Housing supplements helped more than 227 individuals remain in their homes, afford assisted living or long term care. Emergency Assistance Grants went to 246 recipients.

Let's spread Christmas Joy to those who have served our Presbyterian Church so well. The offering also provides over \$1 million to Presbyterian-related schools and colleges equipping communities of color with education and leadership development skills.

“God is with us.” All the time. During this season of Advent, as we approach Christmas, there's no more perfect gift than that. Thank you for sharing those lessons and truths, through your gift to the Christmas Joy Offering.

The Food Bank of Contra Costa and Solano Counties

Every month people served by the Food Bank of Contra Costa and Solano must choose between buying food or paying for other basic needs. In partnership

with 260 local nonprofit organizations, **the Food Bank provides**

3,500,000 meals each month. In order to meet this great need, the Food Bank depends on donations of food and money and they rescue 4,500,000 pounds of food waste each year! 50% of the food they provide is fresh produce. We share their mission of nourishing our neighbors today and advocating for a hunger-free tomorrow.
